Find out the following facts about your English-speaking country:

- Location: where in the world is the country located?
- Size: how big the country is compared to Sweden?
- Population: how many people live there?
- Languages: besides English, what languages are spoken in the country?
- Famous for: Person/place/building/historical event that the country is especially

Show this information on the first slide of your Keynote. You can use both pictures and some words.

b)

- Write down what you want to say to this slide.
- Record yourself.

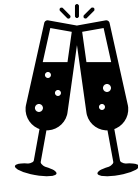


Slide 2

a)

Find out what celebrations and holidays people in your English-speaking country have. Choose 2 or 3 to find out more about.

Choose a picture for each one and show these on your second slide.
Also write the names of the celebrations and holidays on the slide



b)

Now write your own text explaining what your chosen celebrations are about:

- When do they occur (date, time of year)?
- What is the celebration/holiday about, why do they have it?
- What happens, what do people do during the celebration/holiday?
- Write down what you think about the celebrations and holidays and why and if you would like to experience them or maybe already have. Compare them to celebrations and holidays celebrated in your family and/or Sweden, differences and similarities.

Then record your voice reading your text.

Slide 3

a)

Create a slide with some pictures and words showing where your own family have their roots/heritage and which celebrations and holidays your family engages in:

- Where in the world are your parents/grandparents from?
- What languages are spoken in your family?
- Which celebrations and holidays does your family acknowledge and celebrate?
- What do you do, how do you celebrate?

b)
